

Privacy Policy

Introduction

Canapa Skly ("we," "our," or "us") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the personal information of our customers.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our retail location at

211 East 16th Avenue, Vancouver, BC, V5T 2T5, and when you interact with us through our website or other communications.

We comply with British Columbia's Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA) and other applicable privacy legislation.

Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of personal information:

- Contact information (such as name, email address, phone number)
- Identification information (for age verification purposes only)
- Transaction details (purchases made at our store)
- Communication preferences
- Information you provide when you contact us

Note: We will only collect information necessary to fulfill the identified purposes. We do not retain any information longer than necessary.

Purpose of Collection

We collect personal information for the following purposes:

- To verify that you are of legal age to purchase cannabis
- To process sales transactions
- To comply with legal and regulatory requirements
- To provide customer service and respond to inquiries
- To send marketing communications, with your consent
- To improve our services and offerings

Consent

By providing us with your personal information, you consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of that information as described in this Privacy Policy.

You may withdraw your consent at any time, subject to legal or contractual restrictions and reasonable notice.

Disclosure of Your Information

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information to third parties.

We may disclose information in the following cases:

- To comply with legal obligations (e.g., law enforcement requests)
- To service providers who assist us in operating our business (e.g., payment processors)
- In connection with a merger, sale, or transfer of business assets

All service providers are contractually required to protect your information and comply with privacy laws.

Protection of Personal Information

We implement reasonable security measures to protect your personal information from unauthorized

access, use, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

These measures include:

- Secure payment systems
- Access control policies
- Employee training on privacy obligations

Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Access your personal information
- Request correction of inaccurate information
- Withdraw consent for certain uses of your information
- Request deletion of your information, subject to legal obligations
